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Who is ALIMOS ?

Alimos was established in 1967 under the name of Centrale Ortofrutticola to achieve the goal of developing technological innovation in the agricultural sector, protect the environment, the landscape and the health of consumers.



What we achieved ?

We trained hundreds of technicians at a national and international level, enhancing biodiversity to preserve ancient animal and plant species. We pioneered integrated control and the use of beneficial insects in Italy (Biofabbrica) to help cut the use of pesticides and foster organic farming. We created and constantly develop the first network of educational farms in Italy, whose goal is to strengthen the link between city and countryside and contribute to children's education. As of 2005 we have focused our action on schools, promoting health campaigns to tackle obesity and overweight among young people.

We have launched a project called Frutta Snack, financed by regional bodies and ministries. This project aims to cut the consumption of unhealthy snacks, promoting instead healthy fruit and vegetables snacks at school.

From 2009 we are actively involved in the Community SCHOOL FRUIT SCHEME, promoted in Italy by the Ministry of Agriculture to increase healthy eating habits among primary school kids.
